Dear Participant:

Noblesville Swim Club would like to invite you to participate in the Noblesville Swimming "Save Our Pool" Marathon on August 27, 2010. This marathon is being held in order to raise money to offset the operational costs related to keeping the NHS Freshman Campus Pool open for the coming year.

As you may or may not know the Noblesville School Board has included the closure of the NHS Freshman Campus pool in their necessary budgetary cuts for the 2010-2011 school year. Bret Richardson, NOB parent, made an outstanding presentation to the School Board on Tuesday, July 13<sup>th</sup> that resulted in the Board voting to create a committee to work with NOB on a resolution to this problem.

Closure of the NHS Freshman Campus pool would greatly affect all of the programs currently using both this facility and the NHS Main Campus pool as we would have to push 12 hours of programming into just 6 hours – an impossible feat. You or your family members are a part of this programming and are encouraged to participate in this endeavor.

What is the marathon all about? We are looking for 96 people to participate in this marathon – 4 people swimming together for a one-hour period – but we will certainly make room for more. Each group of 4 will swim for one hour straight and not exit the pool until the next 4 enter in order to keep the swimming going for 24 hours straight. The marathon will run Friday, August 27, 2010 at 6 pm to Saturday, August 28, 2010 at 6 pm.

Each participant is encouraged to raise at least \$100 for the "Save Our Pool" project, but for every dollar raised over \$100, \$.20 will be given to *Outreach*, an organization that helps homeless youth in Indianapolis with physical, spiritual and emotional needs. Any participant raising \$100-\$200 will receive a "Save Our Pool" t-shirt. Participants who raise \$201 or more will receive the t-shirt, and a \$100 credit for their family user fee for this year. All donations are tax deductible.
