



Enchanted Forest 2017 NOBLESVILLE SWIM CLUB 7-9 Jul 2017

- SANCTION:** This meet is sanctioned by USA Swimming and Indiana Swimming, Inc. Sanction Number (#IN17344)
- HOST:** NOBLESVILLE SWIM CLUB, Noblesville, Indiana (NOB-IN)
- LOCATION:** Forest Park Aquatic Center, 701 St. Rd. 19, Noblesville, Indiana 46060.
- FACILITY:** 10-lane, 50-meter outdoor pool with a 7-lane 25-yard warm down diving well. The pool depth at the start end is 4'5". The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). Colorado Automatic Timing System will be used. Due to limited pool deck seating, please bring a folding chair.
- RULES:** Current USA Swimming and Indiana Swimming rules will govern this meet. Coaches and Officials MUST display their current USA Swimming coach credential or Deck Pass to gain deck access. **The Meet Referee and/or Meet Director reserves the right to ask for coach credential or Deck Pass and/or deny deck access if coach does not comply or card is no longer valid/current.** Please send this proof with your club's entries. Swimmers must be registered with USA Swimming to be accepted into this meet. Age as of **07 July 2017**, shall determine swimmer's age group for the entire meet. Indiana Swimming does not process on-site registrations/memberships.

Any swimmer entered in the meet, must be certified by a USA Swimming-member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

USA Swimming Rules 202.5.3 - At a sanctioned competitive event, USA Swimming athlete members must be under the supervision of a USA Swimming member coach during warm-up, competition, and warm-down. The Meet Director or Meet Referee may assist in making arrangements for such supervision, but it is the swimmer's responsibility to make such arrangements prior to the start of the meet.

Swim Suit Legislation – Effective 25 January 2010 (102.9.1 B)

In swimming competitions, the competitor must wear only one swimsuit in one or two pieces except as provided in USA Swimming Rule 205.10.1. All swimsuits shall be made from textile materials. For men, the swimsuit shall not extend above the navel nor below the knees, and for women, shall not cover the neck, extend past the shoulder, nor extend below the knee.

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms

Deck changes are prohibited.



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ENTRY LIMIT: Swimmers will be limited to 3 events per day, except 10 & U swimmers will be limited to 4 events a day. If an entry is submitted with an individual entered in more events than this rule allows, he/she will be placed in the first events entered in numerical order. There will be **NO REFUNDS** except for entries which are not accepted or are scratched at our option due to time constraints prior to the start of the meet.

Enter swimmers using **LONG COURSE TIMES ONLY. NO TIMES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED**, however the Coach may estimate when a current time is not available. All entry fees must be paid and a completed Summary of Entries submitted prior to the start of the meet.

Deck entries may be accepted at the discretion of Noblesville Swim Club but will be access a late entry fee of double the entry fee per event.

DEADLINE: All entries must arrive via email. Entries will be accepted starting **22 May 2017. Entries sent before that date will not be accepted. An email confirmation will be sent within 24 hours of receipt of the file. This does not acknowledge acceptance into the meet; only receipt of the file.** Should you not receive a confirmation email please contact the entry chair by telephone prior to the entry deadline. The entry deadline will be **6 June 2017**. Any accepted team entries may be updated until NOON on **Monday, 3 July 2017**. Updated times must be received via email.

The Noblesville Swim Club reserves the right to limit the number of heats and/or combine heats in all events to keep the timeline manageable. There will be refunds for any limited event. Psych sheets for limited events will be posted to the Noblesville Swim Club website no later than NOON 4 July 2017. All entrants for the 1500 Freestyle event must provide their own counters. This meet has been approved as an Officials Qualifying Meet (OQM) for all N2 positions. Any official desiring to be evaluated for recertification or evaluation of N2 positions must complete a Request for Evaluation form and submit it to Mickey Smythe prior to the start of the meet. N2 Evaluations must be done over 3 sessions in the position. Recertification evaluation must be done over two sessions, however, the official MUST WORK at least 4 sessions at the 2017 Enchanted Forest Meet to receive an evaluation.

There will be a required officials briefings one hour before each session. Officials interested in an assigned position for the meet please contact Jeff DeCocq.

FORMAT:

The meet will be conducted in a Preliminary-Finals format except for all Friday events and all 10 & under events. 11-12, 13-14, and Open Age Groups will swim consolations and finals, with the fastest 20 swimmers from each age group. All 10 & under events will be timed finals.

SCRATCHES:

The 30-minute scratch rule will apply. This means a swimmer must notify the Scratch Table of his/her intention not to swim in consolations or finals within 30 minutes of the announcement of preliminary results of his/her event. Scratches will be taken at the announcer's table located on the deck. If a swimmer misses their preliminary event, they will be declared a "No Show" and no accommodations will be made to allow the swimmer to make up the missed event. Any swimmer qualifying for the original B or A Saturday Final in an individual event who fails to compete in said final shall be barred from further competition for the remainder of the meet. SUNDAY ONLY: No-Shows or not scratching according to the rules by the appropriate deadlines, for original/initial consolation finals or finals will result in a \$50 fine per swimmer regardless of the number of events missed that finals session. The fine shall be assessed to the swimmer.

SIGN-IN:

All swimmers MUST sign in at the south end of the pool, 45 minutes prior to the start of the session. Failure to sign in may result in the swimmer being scratched for the day.

AWARDS:

8 & U, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14

Medals- 1st- 10th place

Ribbons- 11th -20th place

High Point – Top 3 male and female athletes

15 & older

High Point - Top 10 male and female athletes

Results for Friday afternoon events (400IM & 400 Free) will be separated by age group 12 & U, 13-14, 15 & Over, but will only be scored and awarded for 13 & over. The 1500 events will be scored as open events.

The High Point awards for an age group will be announced and handed out at the conclusion of that age group's final session. All other awards will be given to the coaches of each team after the meet.

No awards will be mailed unless a SASE mailer is provided to the Noblesville Swim Club Meet Director. Noblesville Swim Club will provide IN Swimming with an official copy of the results immediately after the completion of the meet so your results will be available in their times database.



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Clerk Of Course: There will be NO Clerk of Course for this meet.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- Locker rooms with shower and restroom are available; however, no lockers are available. Noblesville Swim Club will not be responsible for any lost or stolen items.
- No Tobacco use is permitted in or around the pool area.
- No glass containers are allowed in the pool area.
- Breakfast, lunch and snack items will be available at the concession stand.
- This pool will be opened and managed by the Friends of Central Pool management and all activities are subject to their rules and regulations. Persons violating the facility regulations or failing to comply with management requests will be asked to leave the facility.
- Admissions Fees will be posted at the entry gate.

SCHEDULE:

Friday Afternoon Timed Finals: Gates open at 10:30 A.M. Warm-up 11:00 A.M to 11:50 A.M. Sign in sheets come down: 11:15 A.M. Meet begins: noon

Friday P.M. Timed Finals: Sign-in and warm-up begin immediately after the conclusion of the afternoon Timed Finals, but not before 4:00 P.M. Sign in ends: 45 minutes prior to the start of the session. Meet begins immediately following warm-up but not before 5:00 P.M.

Saturday & Sunday A.M. Prelims: Gates open at 6:15 A.M. Warm-up 6:30 A.M. to 7:25 A.M. Sign in sheets come down: 6:45 A.M. Meet begins: 7:30 A.M.

Saturday & Sunday P.M. Prelims and Timed Finals: Sign-in and warm-up begin immediately after the conclusion of the A.M. session, but not before noon. Sign in ends: 45 minutes prior to the start of the session. Meet begins immediately following warm-up but not before 12:45 P.M.

The pool will be available for extended warm-up use immediately following the last prelim event.

Warm-up for finals will begin after the last of the preliminary events, but not before 5:30 P.M. Finals will not begin before 6:30 P.M.

SAFETY:

This is an outdoor facility and there is the possibility of dangerous weather forcing a delay, change or cancellation of events. In **ALL CASES**, the advice and direction of the pool facility management as to the determination of whether or not it is safe to have swimmers in the pool or anyone on the pool deck is final.

The safety of all participants and spectators is of the highest priority. All persons using the facility are required to obey the facility management staff at all times regarding safety issues. Any persons not following these instructions will be removed from further participation in the event.

The Meet Referee will make every effort to run the events as published but reserves the right to delay and or reschedule for a later time any events which are interrupted or delayed due to weather issues. IF necessary to accommodate the time schedule any PRELIM event may be converted to a TIMED FINAL event before, during, or after the event.
